

ACE EMANIFEST INBOND T&E SHIPMENT FORM GUIDE

The following are basic line-by-line explanations of the form used to collect Inbond T&E information needed to create an electronic manifest. If not sure of an explanation please call. We will be glad to further explain or answer any of your questions. To avoid delays or problems at the border we recommend printing clearly. For example, the difference between an S and a 5 can be the difference between a successful crossing or not. Taking an extra minute to print clearly may save hours at the border.

SHIPMENT CONTROL NUMBER – Enter the shipment control number that corresponds to the in bond T&E shipment.

ENTRY / INBOND NUMBER – Enter the Entry or Inbond Number from the bond.

TARRIF CODE – A number used to classify a product. If unknown leave blank, eManifest Service Centre will look up the code.

U.S DESTINATION (FOUR DIGIT CODE) – A number that identifies the place in the United States where the shipment will be transported. If unknown leave blank, eManifest Service Centre will look up the code.

FOREIGN DESTINATION (FIVE DIGIT CODE) - A number that identifies the place where the shipment will go after it is exported from the United States. If unknown leave blank, eManifest Service Centre will look up the code.

BONDED CARRIER ID – Your identification number as a bonded carrier.

4 DIGIT UN CODE – Four-digit number identifying the hazardous material.

DATE OF U.S. EXPORT – Earliest expected date of export.
